SAFEGUARDING POLICY

LITTLE GLEMHAM PARISH COUNCIL

[In respect of Community Area, Church Road, Little Glemham]

In the interests of child protection and the welfare and protection of vulnerable adults, Little Glemham Parish Council is committed to the policy of safeguarding vulnerable adults and children, and, where they may operate events themselves, will ensure that members involved are adequately checked. Little Glemham Parish Council adopts the following policy in respect of safeguarding.

Any organisation which may make contact with vulnerable adults or children shall be required to show proof of its own appropriate safeguarding policy before being allowed to participate in the use of the facility.

Children using the facility would be the responsibility of their parents.

Any organised events which may be open to children and vulnerable adults will have appropriate staffing with all the required credentials before proceeding.

Any organisation or group using the facility for youth sports will be required to show proof of DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) or other valid checks before being allowed to commence activities.

No member of the management committee will be undertaking any activities which leave them alone with children. If it is likely that such a scenario will occur then a full DBS check will have to be obtained prior to the activity.

In the event that some events or organisations open to children or vulnerable adults do not satisfy the above requirements, activities will be denied, but support will be given to the groups or organisations to assist them in attaining the necessary credentials to carry out their activities in the future.
